1. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and its rules shall govern. There will be a Combined Doe Show, a Junior Doe Show, and a Buck Show. They are sanctioned for the following breeds: COMBINED DOE SHOWS: Nigerian, Nubian, Oberhasli, AOP (Alpine, Lamancha, Saanen, Sables and Toggenburg) and Recorded Grade; JUNIOR DOE SHOWS: Nigerian, Nubian, Oberhasli, and AOP (Alpine, Lamancha, Saanen, Sables and Toggenburg). BUCKS: Nigerian, AOP (Alpine, Lamancha, Saanen, Sables and Toggenburg). The Combined Shows and Junior Shows are separately sanctioned. Show order is subject to change only in case of any emergency as determined by the show committee.
2. Breeds receiving enough paid entries prior to 5/6/2020 to become officially sanctioned and keep AOP with sufficient numbers to be official will be separated into their own breed class and be officially sanctioned as well.
3. The base date for computing the age of the goat entered is June 13, 2020.
4. Health Regulations: All out-of-state exhibitors must have a health certificate signed by a veterinarian within 30 days of the show. All animals will be checked for contagious disease (sore mouth, pink-eye, ring worm, open abscess, diarrhea, etc) by either the DE Dept. of Agriculture or the show committee. Any herds exhibiting signs will not be allowed to show. The decision of the show committee is final. Any animals known to be positive for CAE, Johnes, CL or any other contagious diseases shall not be brought to the show property.
5. The original registration is required for all animals. A stamped duplicate (good for 30 days from date of issue) will be accepted for all animals under six months of age.
6. Check-in will begin no later than 8:30 AM on Saturday. Animals must be on the grounds by 9:00 AM. Showmanship classes will begin at 9:00 AM sharp with prizes awarded to winners. Breed classes will begin at 9:30 AM/conclusion of showmanship classes. You may arrive on Friday evening and “camp”. There is access to water, limited electric, and a Port-o-let on site.
7. Entry fee is \$10 per head per ring received or entered online on or before May 6th, 2020.
 - a. Show day substitutions will be allowed within the breed in the same show only.

 - c. Late Entries will be \$15.00 per animal
 - d. If you have entered and cannot attend, please notify the show committee ASAP so that we can make an effort to keep all breed classes with enough numbers to remain official. 302-542-1062 Cell
8. We will not have penning available therefore you must show from your trailer. There should be space to allow your animals off your trailer but you will need to supply penning etc. Trailer areas MUST BE CLEANED before leaving.
9. All Best of Breed winners must be present for the Best Doe in Show class.
10. ADGA, Amazing Grace Acres, Ritter Family Farms Inc., the property owners, nor the show committee will be responsible for loss, damage, or accident to any person, animal, or property. Show entry indicates acceptance of all conditions in this form. Your entry into the show and arrival on show day indicates your agreement to indemnify and hold harmless ADGA, Amazing Grace Acres, Ritter Family Farms Inc., the property owners, and the show committee as well as any and all individuals involved with the show. Your attendance and participation in the show are voluntary and at your own risk.
11. Dogs are not permitted on the premises or near the show ring.
12. No roaming beyond the show area will be permitted. Please watch children carefully.
13. There will be a \$35 bank fee charged for any returned checks.
14. Show books may be left near the secretaries' tables as a convenience to the exhibitors during the show.
